



Chichicapa

Chichicapa is a classic Del Maguey expression and one of the most universally recognizable.

Produced by palenquero Faustino Garcia Vasquez, Chichicapa is made from local Espadín and twice-distilled in wood-fired copper pot stills.

Chichicapa is the classic archetype of a great Oaxacan broad valley mezcal, and Faustino's signature flavor profile has made it a favorite of bartenders globally since the 90s.
