



San Luis del Rio

One of the first two expressions that Del Maguey brought to the US in 1995, alongside Chichicapa.

The village of San Luis Del Rio is located in a narrow, hot valley, its steep slopes full of Espadín.

The Red Ant River flows through the village, with the family's two palenques on opposite sides of the riverbank.

The scent of the old mango grove lingers in the air and adds a signature note to this expression, alongside a green pepper spice and rich earthiness.
